The Nesbitt Centre empowers adults with intellectual disabilities through strength-based and community-led English-language programmes, vocational training, and meaningful employment opportunities with our five social enterprises and community partners. Established in 1993 to address the critical need for accessible services for Hong Kong's English-speaking community, our charitable, not-for-profit organisation fosters a vibrant community that celebrates everyone's strengths. Through innovative life skills training and work opportunities, we enable our members to unlock their potential, promoting independence and belonging across Hong Kong. ACSVAW (the Association Concerning Sexual Violence Against Women)

Established on 8 March 1997, Association Concerning Sexual Violence Against Women (ACSVAW) is a non-government charitable organisation that works to raise awareness of sexual violence against women and promotes a gender equal environment. ACSVAW advocates for both the government and the community to provide adequate support to victims, to defend their rights and restore their lives with confidence and dignity. ACSVAW started the Anti480 - Anti-Sexual Violence Resource Centre (Anti480) in 2005 to actively combat sexual violence and enhance gender equity through a variety of programs implemented on campuses and within communities. Over the past 20 years, Anti480 has developed a prominent brand dedicated to anti-sexual violence education programs, as well as the provision of training materials for adolescents and community members. Anti480 has conducted more than 1,000 educational activities across secondary schools and universities, engaging over 110,000 teenagers in its initiatives. Beyond preventative education, ACSVAW actively advocates for legal reforms in Hong Kong to better support victim-survivors, striving to build a just system and a supportive environment essential for healing and recovery.
